


Back to School

As summer winds down and families prepare for the back-to-school season, our pets often notice the change in routine just as much as we do. After weeks of extra attention, playtime, and activity at home, the shift to quieter days can leave some pets feeling anxious, bored, or even a little down. At ASVC, we know transitions like this can be tough on our furry friends, so here are some tips to help make the adjustment easier.



Pets thrive on predictability. Try to keep meals, walks/potty breaks, and play sessions at about the same time each day. Consistency helps your pet feel secure, even when the household is changing. If they're not on a schedule that lines up with your routine, start shifting activites by 5 minutes each day to try and make that change easier for them.

A little enrichment goes a long way. Puzzle feeders, treat-dispensing toys, or a favorite chew can keep pets entertained and prevent boredom. For dogs, a morning walk or quick play session before everyone leaves can help them relax throughout the day. For both cats and dogs, just 10 to 15 minutes of one-on-one playtime before school or after work can make a big difference.

Recognize Signs of Stress Early

Some dogs may show stress through barking, chewing, accidents, or clingy behavior. Cats may hide more, vocalize, seem restless, and symtoms like loss of appetite can show up in both cats and dogs! If you notice changes in your pet's behavior, it may be their way of saying they need extra support. If your pet struggles with being alone, start with short departures (like running an errand) and gradually increase the time away. This helps them learn that you always come back.

Big life changes, like kids heading back to school can be hard on pets too. With a little planning, you can help them feel safe and loved during the transition. World Rabies Day: Protesting Pets, People, and Communities

September 28 is **World Rabies Day**, a global reminder of the importance of rabies prevention.
Rabies is a deadly virus that affects mammals, including humans, and is almost always fatal once symptoms appear. The good news? Rabies is preventable with proper vaccination.

Why Rabies Vaccination Matters

- Protects Your Pet: Even indoor pets are at risk if they encounter a bat or other wild animal. (One of our staff members found a bat in their house just last month!!)
- Protects Your Family: Vaccinating pets creates a safety barrier between wildlife and humans.
- Protects Our Community: Widespread vaccination keeps outbreaks from spreading through neighborhoods.

Plus, it's a <u>state law</u> in lowa to have your pet's rabies vaccination up-to-date!

What You Can Do

- Keep your pet's rabies vaccination up-to-date.
- Supervise pets outdoors and avoid contact with wildlife.
- If you find a bat in your home, contact your local animal control or health department and get your pet's Rabies vaccination boostered immediately.
